

What is a Duppy?

A ghost or restless spirit is known as a 'Duppy' in Jamaica, or a Jumbie in many smaller Caribbean islands. Traditionally, a good duppy is usually a deceased family member or friend who 'dreams you' – meaning they appear in your dreams and give you advice or information.



THE START OF YOUR EXPERIENCE

You should have a small bag of salt, a small bag of fish food and a small bottle of water in your pocket ready to be used when asked through the experience. The Front of House at Trinity can hand you those items.

At the start of your experience, you will be mainly at Trinity gardens so if you have any problems please go to the Front of House staff member and they will help you.
